
HALE-BYRNES HOUSE AMERICAN REVOUTION ROUND TABLE-NDE JUNE 7, 2025



America's forgotten Founding Father, Dr. Joseph Warren, was involved in almost every major insurrectionary act in the Boston area from the Stamp Act protests to the Boston Massacre to the Boston Tea Party.

Joseph Warren's incendiary writings included the famous Suffolk Resolves which helped unite the colonies against Britain and inspired the Declaration of Independence.
